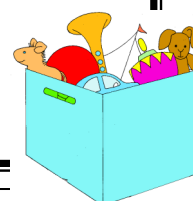

We are having our Matariki star gazing a little later this year due to the Covid-19 lockdown. It is a very special part of how we do things here and we would love you to join us.

Matariki signals the Maori New Year. It is a time of renewal and celebration in New Zealand that begins with the rising of the Matariki Star cluster. Matariki is the Maori name for the small cluster of stars also known as the Pleiades or the Seven Sisters, in the Taurus constellation. In New Zealand it comes into view low on the north eastern horizon, appearing in the tail of the Milky Way in the last days of May or in early June, just before dawn.
