

Board of Trustees Casual Vacancy

Last week we sent out a notice informing of a casual vacancy for a parent representative for the BOT.

The board has decided to fill the vacancy by selection.

If 10% or more of eligible voters on the school roll ask the board, within 28 days of the notice being published, to hold a by-election to fill the vacancy, then a by-election will be held. Request for a byelection should be sent to: Mel Baxter, Presiding Chair c/- Manakau School by 8th July 2024.



Notice of Asbestos Removal Work

We are informing our community that there is going to be removal of some asbestos at school during the July holidays. Commencing on 8 July 2024 and is expected to finish on 9 July 2024.

Manakau School management and board of trustees have been consulted about the nature and timing of this work, together with the safety measures to be used.

- We are recommending that you do not visit the school over these 2 days.
- Signs and temporary fencing/barriers will be installed.
- PVA solution or water will be applied to asbestos containing materials to prevent airborne asbestos fibres dust as required.
- Air monitoring at the work site boundary will be in place for the duration of the work.
- Asbestos containing material will be wrapped on site and disposed of at an approved site.
- An independent party will carry out an inspection of the site on completion of the work, and issue a clearance certificate.


