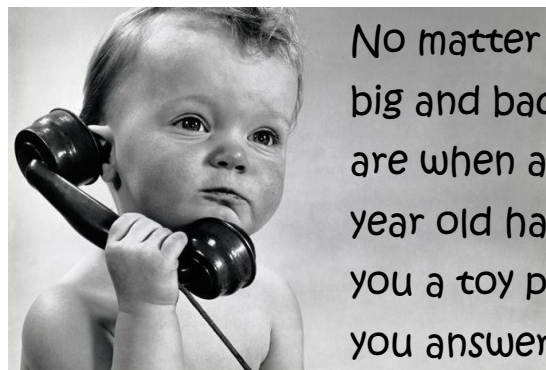
El Rancho Winterland Kids Camp
